Terms & Conditions for Guest Teachers[Walk-in-interview for Guest Teachers 2025-26]

All the guest teachers/staff selected and appointed after due selection process will be governed by terms and conditions issued by NESTS/OMTES through its letters from time to time. Candidates are advised to refer following letters.

- 1. NESTS/EMRS/stateissue /100/ 2021-22, dated: 08-08-2024,
- 2. NESTS /Admin/ Recruitment & RO/ 2023-part, dated: 30-07-2024
- 3. NESTS/State /Recruitment /22 /2020-2021, dated: 20-07-2022

Candidates should read following points carefully and appear for interview only if he/she agrees to abide by the following terms and conditions.

- 1. The committee reserve the right to increase / decrease the number of vacancies given in the advertisement.
- 2. The committee reserve the right to select any candidate found extremely talented, bypassing selection criteria.
- 3. Remuneration to the guest teacher will be purely on period basis, Rs. 320/- per period for PGT, Rs. 300/- per period for TGT.
- 4. Salary of retired government teachers will on monthly basis as specified in the Guidelines for Engaging Guest Teachers.
- 5. The guest teacher shall not claim any right to regularisation of their service on account of this engagement.
- 6. Selected candidate will be engaged only for one academic year i.e 2025-26. However, their service can be terminated if regular staff is appointed by the NESTS/OMTES.
- 7. Service of the guest teacher/staff can be terminated at any point of time without assigning any reason thereof.
- 8. Minimum and maximum age shall be 21 years and 60 years respectively on the date of appearing for interview.
- 9. The maximum age limit for retired teachers shall be 65 years provided that they are medically fit to work in a residential set up.
- 10. Leave of any kind shall be considered as absent and that will be considered as leave without pay.
- 11. Unauthorised absence for 10 days at a stretch will automatically terminate his/her engagement.
- 12. Working hours of the guest teacher/staff will be same as regular teacher/staff. Guest teachers have to take afternoon remedial class and evening supervised class as per school time table.
- 13. The duties and responsibilities of the guest teachers shall be same or at par with the regular teacher/incumbent viz. regular classroom activity, copy correction, invigilation duty, evaluation duty, preparing students for various literary, co-curricular, sports activities, escorting duty, house master duty, nomination for training programmes, and any duty assigned by the Principal.
- 14. Guest teacher may be provided accommodation if it is available. In case of non-availability of accommodation in the school campus they have to arrange it themselves. No HRA will be paid to guest teachers.

- 15. If accommodation is available and provided by the school, guest teacher compulsorily has to stay in the school campus.
- 16. The candidate has to submit an undertaking, in the form of court affidavit, that he/she will abide by all terms and conditions [mentioned above] of NESTS/OMTES/EMRS.
- 17. Candidate having experience of working in residential schools will be given preference.
- 18. No salary/remuneration will be paid for summer vacation / winter vacation and autumn break. No salary/remuneration will be paid for Sundays and other holidays declared by the school.
- 19. No TA/DA will be paid for attending interview.
