

POST DOCTORAL FELLOW (PDF)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Institute of Mathematics and Applications, (IMA) Bhubaneswar offers Post Doctoral Fellowships (PDF) to selected young mathematicians who have completed their PhD degree in Mathematics. The IMA PDFS are mathematicians below the age of 35 who have a doctoral degree or equivalent published research work. Persons who have submitted their dissertations for a PhD degree are also eligible to apply. The Post Doctoral Fellows are expected to be engaged in teaching along with research work at IMA.

The application should consist of:

1. A duly filled in IMA PDF Application Form,
2. Synopsis of the thesis, and/or related work (maximum two pages),
3. List of journal publications link (including communicated/accepted)

The fellowship is tenable for two years in the first instance, and is extendable for a third year after a review by IMA. The fellowship may be terminated after one year in case of no satisfactory performance. Years are to be counted from the date of joining. The Fellowship normally commences from 1st day of a calendar month.

1. IMA Post-doctoral Fellowship consists of the following:

Fellowship	Rs.58, 000/- 1 st year
	Rs. 61,000/-2 nd year
	Rs.67, 000/- 3 rd year

2. Contingency Grant is Rs.40,000/- per annum. The Contingency Grant can be utilized for the following:
 - (a) Purchase of books and stationary items. Books purchased by the scholar, from the contingency grant, to be submitted to the IMA Library after tenure of the PDF is over.
 - (b) Photographic materials for research work.
 - (c) Reprints/offprints of research papers.
 - (d) Stationary and postal charges
 - (e) Registration fee for attending conferences in India and abroad.
 - (f) T. A. (as per Govt. Norm) for attending conferences inside India.
 - (g) Stationary items such as Pens, Pencils, Folders, File Covers, Papers etc.
 - (h) Any other purpose specifically authorized by the Institute.

N.B:

- No expenditure can be incurred for purchase of furniture and office equipment.
- The Contingency Grant can not be utilized for Foreign Travel or other expenses for Visit Abroad.
- 3. House Rent Allowance is admissible as per government of Odisha rules.
- 4. Reader Allowance of Rs.2.000/- per month (for visually handicapped persons only).
- 5. The Post Doctoral Fellow should be provided hostel/subsidized accommodation wherever available.

Where this is not possible, house rent allowance as per government norms will be paid.

A duly filled in form (original) along with enclosures completed in all respect should be sent to IMA office by Speed Post/ Registered Post to the ‘Director, Institute of Mathematics and Applications, P.O-Andharua, Bhubaneswar, Odisha 751029’. Selection Procedure

Selection to the IMA Post Doctoral Fellow will be made based on the presentation of the proposed research project followed by interview of short listed candidates.
