Applications are invited for engagement of one Field Biologist with a monthly fixed remuneration of Rs 50,000/-at Redhakhol Forest Division. The engagement is purely temporary and is initially for a period of one year which may likely to continue for next year(s) subject to satisfactory performance.

Essential Qualification:

Graduation/Post Graduation in, Wildlife Science, Botany, Zoology, Forestry, Life Science, Natural Resource Management, Agriculture, Environmental Science, Agricultural Science, Veterinary Science, Biotechnology With minimum 65% aggregate marks from a recognized university.

Desirable Qualification:

- Prior experience in wildlife management, sampling design, and animal abundance estimation preferred.
- Ability to work in harsh field conditions.
- Knowledge of GIS and Remote Sensing is desirable.
- Research or peer reviewed publications in wildlife or Forest Management.

Emoluments:

Age Limit:

Upper age limit 32 years as on 01.01.2025, including age relaxation up to 5 years in case of SC/ST/SEBC candidates.

Duties of a Field Biologist (Elephant Conservation Focus)

1. Population Estimation

- a. Use **direct methods** (e.g., visual counts, camera traps).
- b. Apply **indirect methods** (e.g., dung counts, track surveys) to estimate elephant populations and other wildlife.

2. Field Botanisation

- a. Identify and document elephant-palatable plant species.
- b. Conduct surveys to assess the availability and distribution of these species in the habitat.

3. Habitat Evaluation & Disturbance Assessment

- a. Evaluate habitat quality, including vegetation, water sources, and shelter.
- b. Assess human-induced disturbances (e.g., encroachment, pollution, infrastructure development).

4. Wildlife Research

- a. Conduct field studies on elephants and other wildlife.
- b. Collect data on behavior, movement patterns, diet, and health.

5. Capacity Building

- a. Train frontline staff on modern wildlife management techniques.
- b. Share updates on conservation strategies, legal frameworks, and field technologies.

6. Rescue Team Setup

- a. Establish and train a wildlife rescue team.
- b. Develop protocols for handling conflict situations, injured animals, and emergency responses.

7. Monitoring Elephant Corridors

- a. Regularly monitor **elephant corridors** for usage and threats.
- b. Implement **habitat enrichment** measures like planting palatable species and creating water holes.

8. Other Duties

a. Perform additional tasks as assigned.

Other Conditions:

- 2. **Working hours:** The Field Biologist will be expected to be on duty in Office opening to closing hours. The candidate may be required to work on off days and beyond duty hours on the direction of the Divisional Forest Officer, Redhakhol Forest Division with mutual agreement.
- 3. **Leave:** The candidate is allowed for 12days casual leave per year with prior permission of Divisional Forest Officer, Redhakhol Forest Division.
- 4. **Remuneration:** Total remuneration per month will be Rs. 50,000/- which is all inclusive of House Rent Allowance and other benefits.
