## **REQUIRES**

1. (a) **PGT-English:**

**E.Q.:** Post-Graduation in English & B.Ed.

**Desired experience:** Minimum 3 years' relevant experience of teaching English to Senior Secondary classes (XI & XII) or at least 10 years' relevant experience of teaching English to Secondary classes (IX & X).

(b) **PGT/TGT-Physics:**

**E.Q.:** Post-Graduation in Physics & B.Ed.

**Desired experience:** Minimum 3 years' relevant experience of teaching Physics to Senior Secondary classes (XI & XII) or at least 10 years' relevant experience of teaching Physics to Secondary classes (IX & X).

(c) **PGT/TGT-Computer Science:**

**E.Q.:** B.E., B.Tech. (Computer Science) / BCA / MCA/ M. Sc. (Computer Science), M.Sc. (Electronics with Computer Science Component) / M.Sc. (IT) / B.Sc. (Computer Science)

**OR**

**Bachelor's/Master degree in any Science Subject/Mathematics from recognized University with Post Graduate Diploma in Computer application from government recognized University/Institute.**

**OR**

**Post Graduate degree in any subject with Post Graduate Diploma in Computer application from government recognized University / 'O' level from DOEACC.**

**Desired experience:** Minimum 3 years' relevant experience of teaching Computer Science to UG classes in recognized Colleges or Universities / classes IX to XII only, will be considered.

2. (a) **TGT-English\*:**

**E.Q.:** Post-Graduation in English & B.Ed.

**Desired experience:** Minimum 3 years' relevant experience of teaching English from classes VI to XII only, will be considered.

(b) **TGT-Sanskrit\*:**

**E.Q.:** Post-Graduation in Sanskrit & B.Ed.

**Desired experience:** Minimum 3 years' relevant experience of teaching Sanskrit from classes VI to XII only, will be considered.

(c) **TGT-Art & Craft:**

**E.Q.:** Post Graduation in Fine Arts & B.Ed.

**Desired experience:** Minimum 3 years' relevant experience of teaching Fine arts from classes VI to XII only, will be considered.

(d) **TGT-Physical Education:**

**E.Q.: Graduation with M.P.Ed.**

**Desired experience:** Minimum 3 years' relevant experience of teaching Physical Education from classes VI to XII only, will be considered.

(e) **TGT/PRT-Music (Vocal & Instrumental):**

**E.Q.: Post Graduation in Music & B.Ed.**

**Desired experience:** Minimum 3 years' relevant experience of teaching Music from classes VI to XII only, will be considered.

**\*Preference in selection will be given to those who have qualified CTET/TET (If two candidates selected are of the same level at the end of selection process).**

3. (a) **PRT (Lady Teacher): Maths\*\***

**E.Q.: Graduation/Post Graduation in Maths and D.El.Ed./B.El.Ed./B.Ed.**

**Desired experience:** Minimum 3 years' relevant experience of teaching Maths from classes I to X only, will be considered.

(b) **PRT (Lady Teacher): Social Science\*\***

**E.Q.: Graduation/Post Graduation in History/Geography/Economics/Political Science and D.El.Ed./B.El.Ed./B.Ed.**

**Desired experience:** Minimum 3 years' relevant experience of teaching Social Science from classes I to X only, will be considered.

(c) **PRT (Lady Teacher): Pre-Primary Wing\*\***

**E.Q.: Graduation/Post Graduation in any subject and D.El.Ed./B.El.Ed./B.Ed.**

**Desired experience:** Minimum 3 years' relevant experience of teaching classes I to X only, will be considered.

**\*\*Preference will be given to D.El.Ed./B.El.Ed. holders and CTET/TET qualifiers. If, done B.Ed., candidates must have completed Bridge Course from NIOS.**

(d) **PRT (Lady Teacher):Physical Education:**

**E.Q.: Graduation with M.P.Ed.**

**Desired experience:** Minimum 3 years' relevant experience of teaching Physical Education from classes I to XII only, will be considered.

(e) **PRT (Lady Teacher): Art & Craft**

**E.Q.: Graduation/Post Graduation in Fine Arts & B.Ed.**

**Desired experience:** 3 years' relevant experience of teaching Art & Craft from classes I to XII.

**CANDIDATES WITH LESS EXPERIENCE/FRESHERS CAN ALSO APPLY. HOWEVER, IF SELECTED SUCH CANDIDATE(S), WILL BE APPOINTED ON AD HOC BASIS/CONTRACTUAL BASIS.**

4. **Staff Nurse (Female):**

**E.Q.:** B.Sc. (Hons.) in Nursing or regular B.Sc. Nursing course, or Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing from a recognized institution and must be a Registered Nurse or Nurse-Midwife (RN or RM) with any State Nursing Council.

**Desired experience:** Minimum 3 years' relevant experience as staff nurse in a reputed hospital/education institution only, will be considered.

**Age (Not applicable to internal candidates):** below 45 years for Sl. No. 1 (a to c), below 40 years for Sl. No. 2 (a to e), below 35 years for Sl. Nos. 3 (a to e) & 4.

**Age criterion:** Please note that the desired relevant experience asked for is a part of the age limit given for a particular post.

**Example:** Age of a candidate is 40 years

Desired relevant experience asked for = 3 years

Age limit = 35 years (3 years desired relevant experience is included in this. No age benefit for those having 3 years of desired relevant experience)

**Case A**

- (a) Candidate has desired relevant experience of 5 years
- (b) Age benefit =  $5 - 3 = 2$  years
- (c) Is the candidate eligible for further scrutiny?  
 $40 - 2 = 38$  years which is more than 35 years, so candidate is not eligible for further scrutiny.

**Case B**

- (a) Candidate has desired relevant experience of 10 years
- (b) Age benefit =  $10 - 3 = 7$  years
- (c) Is the candidate eligible for further scrutiny?  
 $40 - 7 = 33$  years. Yes, the candidate is eligible for further scrutiny.

**GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

- (a) **CANVASSING IN ANY FORM WILL RENDER THE CANDIDATE DISQUALIFIED FROM THE POST APPLIED FOR.**
- (b) The Management reserves the right to shortlist candidates to be called for the written test/interview.
- (c) All the columns of the application form must be filled-in properly. Please furnish all the required details as per the format. Incomplete application forms are liable to be rejected and the applicant shall be solely responsible for this.
- (d) Aspiring Candidates should read carefully the requisite essential qualifications, age and eligibility, experience criteria etc. laid down before applying for the relevant post. Fulfillment of qualifications and experience are essential requirements, failing which the application will be rejected. However, mere eligibility will not entitle any candidate for being shortlisted for written test/interview etc.
- (e) Details of all the qualifications obtained starting from class X onwards are to be mentioned in the application form (**Mandatory**).
- (f) **Those who are working in other Delhi Public Schools under the aegis of The DPSS, New Delhi are required to submit NOC from their employer along with the application form.**
- (g) **Shortlisted candidates for written test/interview will be intimated through e-mail only. Hence, candidates are required to provide correct/proper e-mail ID.**
- (h) (i) Candidates who have secured minimum 50% at each level from Class X upto the required minimum qualification, only need apply.  
(ii) However, internal candidates who have the requisite educational qualification(s) and experience may apply.
- (i) **As far as the educational qualifications for the posts, the school follows NCTE norms as prescribed from time to time.**
- (j) Those who are proficient in English will be preferred.
- (k) The final shortlisting of candidates will depend on the number of applications received. The criteria for shortlisting of candidates are subject to revision in case the number of applicants who meet the desired qualifications and experience is more.
- (l) In case the number of candidates applying for a specific post is less, then the desired level of relevant experience may be relaxed.
- (m) In case a candidate does not meet the requirements after the interview for the post (grade) applied for, s/he may be offered a lower grade/salary.
- (n) If someone is found suitable, s/he can be considered, if willing, for lower post also.

(o) **The candidates are required to submit the following along with the application:**

- (i) Photocopies of the marksheets of X, XII, final year graduation, post-graduation, B.Ed., D.Ed., B.Ed., CTET/TET etc.
- (ii) Photocopies of the relevant experience certificates of previous employer(s).
- (iii) Recent salary slip or salary certificate from the current employer.

**Those who do not submit photocopies (wherever applicable) of the marksheets, experience certificate(s) and salary slip or salary certificate, their application will be summarily rejected. No reminders will be sent.**

**Experience certificate(s) must clearly mention the designation, classes taught and salary drawn. Experience certificate(s) of recognized Secondary and Senior Secondary schools will be considered. Play school experience certificate(s) will not be considered.**

(p) **No interim enquiry or correspondence will be entertained.**

(q) **The prescribed essential qualifications and experience are the minimum requirements and mere possession of the same does not entitle a candidate to be shortlisted for interview.**
