Candidates who are declared qualified for attending the interview after review by the school may appear for the interview with their original mark sheets and certificates, one set of photocopies of the same, a passport-size photograph, and an original ID proof, as per the details given below.

Essential Qualifications:

For the post of PGTs (Sl. No. 1 to 5):

a. Integrated Post Graduate Course from NCTE recognized institution/University, in the concerned subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate including B.Ed. component.

OR

Master Degree from a recognized institution/University with at least 50% marks in aggregate in the concerned subject

AND

b. B.Ed. Degree from NCTE recognized institution/University with at least 50% marks

OR

Three years Integrated B.Ed.-M.Ed. from NCTE recognized Institution/University with at least 50% marks

OR

Four years Integrated Degree with at least 50% marks from NCTE recognized Institution/ University including B.Ed. component

c. Proficiency to Teach in Hindi and English medium.

Details of subjects in Master Degree according to the post of PGT are as under:

Sl. No.	Post	Master Degree in the Subject
I.	Commerce	In Commerce. Holder of M. Com. Degree in Applied/ Business Economics shall not be eligible.
II.	English	English, Provided the candidate has studied concerned subject at Graduation level also.

III.	Hindi	Hindi, Provided the candidate has studied concerned subject at Graduation level also.
IV.	Mathematics	In concerned subject or any specialization in concerned subject provided the candidate has studied concerned subject at graduation level also.
V.	Physics	In concerned subject or any specialization in concerned subject provided the candidate has studied concerned subject at graduation level also.

Note: In case of non-availability of candidates with B.Ed. , candidates without B.Ed. may be considered provided that the candidate has secured 60% marks in the Master Degree.

For the Post PGT (Computer Science) (Sl. No. 6):

a. M.Sc. (Computer Science/IT) / MCA from a recognized institution/University with at least 50% marks.
OR

M.E. or M. Tech. (Computer Science/IT) from recognized institution/University with at least 50% marks.

b. B.Ed. Degree from NCTE recognized Institution/University with at least 50% marks

OR

Three years integrated B.Ed.-M.Ed. from NCTE recognized Institution/University with at least 50% marks

OR

Four years integrated degree with at least 50% marks from NCTE recognized institution/University including B.Ed. component.

Note: In case of non-availability of candidates with B.Ed. , candidates without B.Ed. may be considered provided that the candidate has secured 60% marks in the Master Degree.

For the Post of TGTs (English & Sanskrit) (Sl. No. 7 & 8):

a. Four years integrated degree course from NCTE recognized Institution/ University with at least 50% marks in the concerned subject(s) as well as in the aggregate including B.Ed. component.

OR

i. Bachelor/Honours Degree from a recognized institution/University with at least 50% marks in concerned subject, combination of subjects as well as in the aggregate.

ii. B.Ed. Degree from NCTE recognized institution/University with at least 50% marks OR Three years Integrated B.Ed.-M.Ed. from NCTE recognised Institution/University with at least 50% marks

OR

Post-Graduation in concerned subject / any specialization in concerned subject with a minimum 55% marks or equivalent grade provided that the candidate has studied the subject(s) mentioned in the note below at the graduation level and three years integrated B.Ed.-M.Ed. from NCTE recognized institution/University with at least 50% marks.

b. Qualified in the Central Teachers Eligibility Test (Paper-II) conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).

c. Competency to teach through English and Hindi Medium.

Desirable Qualification:

1. Experience of working in a school.

2. Knowledge of Computer applications.

3. Working knowledge of English and Hindi.

Note: The concerned subject mentioned above means the post wise Main / Elective subject(s) and the combination of subject(s) if any are as under:

For the Post of TGTs (Mathematics, Science, & Social Studies) (Sl. No. 9 to 11):

Essential Qualifications:

a. Four years integrated degree course from NCTE recognized university with at least 50% marks in the concerned subject as well as in the aggregate including B.Ed. component.

OR

i. Bachelors/Honours Degree from a recognized university with at least 50% marks in concerned subject, combination of subjects and also in aggregate.

ii. B.Ed. Degree from NCTE recognized institution/University with at least 50% marks.

OR

Three years Integrated B.Ed.-M.Ed. from NCTE recognized Institution/ University with at least 50% marks.

b. Qualified in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (Paper-II) conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE)

c. Competence to teach through English and Hindi Languages.

Note: Post wise elective subjects in the combination of subjects are as under:

The candidates who studied under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) with the above subject combination are also eligible to apply.								

Desirable Qualification:

1. Experience of working in a school.
2. Knowledge of Computer applications.

For Primary Teacher (PRT) (Sl. No. 15):

a. Senior Secondary/Higher Secondary/Intermediate (10+2) with at least 50% marks and 2- year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known) from recognized Institute/Board.

OR

Senior Secondary/Higher Secondary/Intermediate (10+2) with at least 50% marks and 4- year Bachelor of Elementary Education (B. El. Ed.) from recognized Institute/Board

b. Qualified in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (Paper-I) conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).

c. Proficiency to teach through Hindi & English medium.

Desirable: Knowledge of working on Computer.

For Pre-Primary Teacher(Bal-Vatika Teacher) (Sl.No. 16):

a. Senior Secondary (Class XII) or its equivalent from a recognized board with at least 50% marks.

b. Diploma in Nursery Teacher Education / Pre-School Education / Early Childhood Education Programme (D.E.C.Ed) of at least two years' duration, or B.Ed. (Nursery) from an NCTE-recognized institute.

c. Proficiency in English and Hindi.

Note: In case of non-availability of candidates with a two-year qualification as mentioned in point no. 2, candidates with a one-year qualification or candidates having requisite qualification for the Post of Primary teacher may be considered.

For Computer Instructor (Secondary) (Sl. No. 17):

BE/B.Tech(Comp.Sc.)/BCA/MCA/M.Sc.(Comp.Sc.)/M.Sc.(ElectronicswithComp.Sc.)/M.Sc.(IT)/

B.Sc.(Comp.Sc.)/B.Sc(IT)

OR

Bachelor Degree in any Science subject/Math. With PGDCA

OR

Post-Graduate Degree in any subject with PGDCA/O'-Level from DOEACC/A'-Level from DOEACC.

For Counsellor (Sl. No. 18):

Essential qualification B.A/B. Sc(Psychology) with certificate of diploma in counseling.

Desirable: Minimum of one year experience in providing career/educational counseling to students at schools.

Or

Working knowledge and experience in placement bureaus.

Or

Registration with rehabilitation council of India as Vocational counselor.

For Vocational Instructor/ ATL Instructor (Sl. No. 19 & 20):

B.E, B.Tech, Electronic & Communication Engineering.

Desirable: One Year Experience in the relevant field.

For Art & Craft Coach (Sl. No. 21):

Diploma/Degree in the concerned subject with professional competencies.

For Regional Language Teacher (Odia) (Sl. No. 22):

Graduation from a recognized university in the concerned subject with a minimum of 50% marks in the subject as well as in aggregate. B.Ed. from a recognized university is mandatory.

Odia must have been studied as an Elective/Honours/Major subject at the Degree level.

Candidates who have studied Odia only as a compulsory subject at the Degree level are **not eligible** for the said post.

For Dance Coach(Sl. No. 23):

Diploma/Bachelor/Master Degree in the concerned Subject or equivalent from a recognized University.

For Special Educator(Primary) (Sl. No. 24):

a. XII Passed with minimum 50% marks in aggregate

b. Any of the following from recognized university/Institute:

Two-year D.Ed. Special Education in any of the category of disability.

OR

One year Diploma in Special Education (DSE) in any of the category of disability.

OR

Diploma in Community Based Rehabilitation (DCBR) with 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

OR

Post Graduate Diploma in Community Based Rehabilitation (PGDCBR) with 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

OR

Diploma in Multi Rehabilitation Worker (MRW) with 6 months Certificate Course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

OR

Junior Diploma in Teaching the Deaf OR Primary level Teacher Training course in Visual Impairment.

OR

Diploma in Vocational Rehabilitation-Mental Retardation (DVR-MR)/Diploma in Vocational Training and Employment- Mental Retardation (DVTE-MR) with 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

OR

Diploma in Hearing Language and Speech (DHLS) with 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

OR

XII passed with any RCI recognized qualification of minimum one year duration and 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

OR

Any other equivalent qualification approved by RCI

c. Qualified in Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) (Paper – 1) conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).

- d. Registration with Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) and having valid CRR number.
 - e. Proficiency to teach in Hindi and English
- Desirable: Knowledge of Computer Applications

In case of non-availability of CTET qualified candidates, candidates without CTET may be considered. Similarly, in case of non-availability of candidates for the post of Special Educator (Primary), candidates eligible for the post of Special Educator (Secondary) may be considered. The eligibility criteria for Special Educator (Secondary) will be as per KVS Recruitment Rules.

For Sports Coach (Sl. No. 25):

Graduation with recognized Diploma Physical Education or B.P.Ed.
Participation in State/National level games/sports will be given preference.

Other Important Information:

1. **No TA/DA** will be paid for attending the interview.
2. The candidates should have **bilingual competency to teach in English and Hindi.**
3. If the number of candidates for a particular post is more, a **written test may be conducted to shortlist the candidates for the interview.**
4. **Remuneration will be paid as per KVS rules for contractual teachers.**
5. As the school is situated inside **INS Chilka Base(Defence Area)**, entry is restricted subject to verification of identity hence, candidates are requested to bring an **original Government ID proof (preferably Aadhaar Card)** for entry purpose.
