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2. **Selection Process:** Written Test, Class Room Demonstration and Interview. The candidates securing minimum essential marks / short listed in the written test will only be permitted to take part in Classroom Demonstration. Candidates declared pass in Classroom Demonstration only will be interviewed.

3. **Application Fee:** Application Fee (non-refundable) in the form of a Bank Demand Draft for **Rs 500/- drawn in favour of Principal, Sainik School Imphal**, payable at Imphal or Bank of India, Sainik School Branch, Imphal. Application fee can also be deposited online at the School's Bank Account i.e. Bank of India, Sainik School Branch, IFSC Code – BKID0005064, Account Number – 506420110000001. Online payment receipt may please be attached with the application.

4. **How to Apply:** - Eligible candidates may apply to the Principal, Sainik School Imphal, P.O. Pangei Yangdong, Imphal East – 795114, Manipur in the prescribed format available at the school's website (<https://ssimphal.nic.in>) along with attested copies of certificates and testimonials, a passport size photograph, bio-data including working telephone / mobile number, e-mail ID along with a self-addressed envelope with stamp of Rs. 60/-. Applications received after the due date or without supporting documents or prescribed application fee or not in the prescribed format will be rejected without any intimation. (Candidates are advised to forward application through both e-mail and post)

5. **Last Date for Receipt of Applications will be 21 days from the date of publication of the advertisement.** The school will not be responsible for any postal delay and no claim will be entertained in this regard. (Candidates are advised to forward application through both e-mail and post, e-mail of the school is ssimphal@sainikschoolsociety.in).

6. Sainik Schools Society Rules and Regulations presently in vogue and as amended from time to time will be applicable. Age relaxation for SC, ST, OBC and Ex-Serviceman candidates is applicable as per the Central Govt, Rules and Regulations, however, no age relaxation will be provided after the age of 50 years.

7. The school administration reserves the right to cancel the vacancy due to any administrative / policy reasons.

8. Only shortlisted eligible candidates will be called for written test. Candidates will have to make their own arrangements for boarding and lodging during their stay at Imphal which may be 3 to 4 working days. No TA/DA will be admissible for attending the examination. Lunch on recruitment day will be provided at normal charges.

9. Selection will be carried out purely on merit basis. Any candidate indulging in solicitation for selection will be disqualified.



CONDUCT OF WRITTEN TEST, CLASS DEMONSTRATION / SKILL TEST AND INTERVIEW

1. The exam for the post of TGT Maths, TGT Social Science and PGT Computer Science will comprise a Written Test / Classroom Demonstration and an Interview.

(a) **Written Test.** Written test will be of 1 hour duration and will carry 100 marks (Weightage 50%). A candidate will be required to score minimum 50% marks to qualify for the next step of the selection process. However, the minimum required marks may be increased upto 50% by the Board of Officers to limit the number of candidates for the next step of the selection process. The question paper for the written test will be prepared as per details given below:

(b) **Class Demonstration.** Class room teaching abilities will be tested in an actual class of appropriate level. Class Demonstration will carry a maximum of 100 marks (Weightage 30%).

(c) **Interview.** Interview will carry 100 marks (Weightage 15%). The Maximum marks for Higher Qualification and Experience will be 50 (Weightage 5%).
