The applicants must have qualified Master Degree in the concerned subject with at least 50% marks or equivalent grade & B.Ed. or equivalent degree recognized by the NCTE New Delhi, in case of B.Ed. subjects. In case of non-availability of B.Ed. candidates in a particular subject, the candidature of non-B.Ed. candidates may be considered. The selection shall be made through carrier assessment, teaching experience and basic experience in computer application. The guest faculties so engaged shall be paid @Rs400/- per class/lecturer of 45minutes duration subject to a ceiling of maximum 50 classes with Rs.

20,000/- rupees per month. 1. Mode of Engagement- Engagement of guest faculties will be made through open advertisement following due procedure as detailed below
2. Tenure – One year from the date of engagement
3. No. of Guest faculties to be engaged-
 - Not more than total existing vacancies vis-à-vis the sanctioned posts.
 - In upgraded HSS guest faculties are to be engaged in the following subjects only in addition to the compulsory subjects (Odia & English)
 - Arts- History, Political Science, Economics, Odia Optional
4. Preference & Procedure of selection- Selection is to be made as per the following order of preference: -
 - Retired Government College/OSS teachers of the same institution who have not completed 65 years of age, if their pre-retirement performance was up to the mark
 - Retired teachers of other Government College/HSS who have not completed 65 years of age. If availability of such retired teachers exceeds the requirement, the principal will select the most suitable one
 - Retired teachers of Aided College/HSS who have not completed 65 years of age and who were in receipt of GIA from Government. If availability of such retired teachers exceeds the requirement, the principal will select the most suitable one.




