**Notice for Walk-In-Interview for Engagement of Retired Teachers on Contractual Basis at
Belpahari Residential Government Girls' Higher Secondary School for Scheduled Tribes, Jhargram**

With reference to Memo No. 270/BCWTD (H) dated 19/09/2025 of the Project Officer (HQ), BCW&TD Directorate & Ex-Officio Joint Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, eligible and willing female retired teachers are hereby invited to appear in the Walk-in-interview for engagement on a purely contractual and temporary basis against the following vacant posts at Belpahari Residential Government Girls' Higher Secondary School for Scheduled Tribes, Jhargram.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Only female retired teachers who retired at the age of 60 years under the ROPA-2019 scale of pay as full-time approved teachers and are below 64 years of age as on 01/06/2026 may apply.
2. Applicants must have retired from Government, Government-aided or Government-sponsored Secondary, Higher Secondary or Primary Schools.
3. For Secondary and Higher Secondary levels, the applicant must have taught the concerned subject during her service tenure.
4. The retired teacher must be physically fit and mentally alert to perform duties as a contractual teacher, including invigilation, scrutiny of answer scripts, tutorial classes and other academic responsibilities assigned from time to time.
5. Teachers who were compulsorily retired as a measure of punishment, or who retired voluntarily on grounds of illness or incapacity, or who have been charged with or convicted of any criminal offence involving moral turpitude, shall not be considered.

Mode of Selection

1. Selection shall be made through a Personality Test-cum-Interview (Total Marks: 50), taking into account teaching experience, academic qualifications and overall suitability.
2. The Selection Committee reserves the right to make any modification to the selection process, if considered necessary.

Terms of Engagement

1. Engagement shall be made purely on a temporary and contractual basis for a period of one year, renewable subject to requirement and satisfactory performance.
2. Remuneration shall be determined on the basis of "Last Pay minus Pension", as per Government norms and orders in force.
3. No TA/ DA shall be admissible for attending the interview or for joining the assignment.

- b. Educational Qualification Certificates and Mark Sheets
- c. Professional Qualification Certificate (B.Ed./ D.El.Ed./ equivalent, as applicable)
- d. Pension Payment Order (PPO)
- e. Retirement Order / Release Order / Proof of Retirement
- f. Aadhaar Card or EPIC
- g. Two recent passport-size photographs

General Instructions

1. Registration of candidates shall be conducted on the date of interview between 11:00 A.M. and 12:00 Noon. No candidate shall be allowed to register after the stipulated time.
2. Candidates must produce all original testimonials for verification.
3. Mere appearance in the interview shall not confer any right to engagement.
4. Canvassing in any form shall lead to immediate disqualification.
5. If any declaration or information furnished by a candidate is found to be false or incorrect at any stage, her candidature shall be cancelled forthwith.
6. The authority reserves the right to cancel, postpone, modify or withdraw the recruitment process, wholly or partly, at any stage without assigning any reason.


