3. Age Limit: -The Minimum age of the applicant should be 21 years and the maximum age should be 60 years as on 31-03-2026. Retired teachers from NVS/KVS/State Government/ recognized reputed CBSE schools may also be engaged as a Guest Teacher. The maximum age limit for retired teachers shall be 65 years provided that they are medically fit to work in a residential setup.

Teachers will be engaged from the panel as per requirement or as per the directions of NESTS, subject to clearing the Pre-Recruitment Medical Examination, document verification, and any other required verification.

9. TERMS & CONDITIONS: -

- The engagement of Guest Teachers will be purely temporary for the academic session 2026-27 or till the joining of regular teachers, whichever is earlier.
- The guest teachers shall not claim any right to regularization of their services on account of this engagement.
- The candidate should not have any criminal record and no case should be pending against him/her in any court of law.
- The service of guest teachers can be terminated at any time without assigning any reasons or prior intimation.
- The working hours of Guest Teachers shall be the same as those of regular teachers.
- Guest Teachers will be required to remain available as per the needs of the residential school.
- The duties and responsibilities of guest teachers shall be same or at par with the regular teacher viz regular classroom activities, remedial class, supervised study, copy correction, co- curricular, sports activities, escorting duty, duties assigned by the principal etc no extra payment will be done for the same.
- Guidelines issued by NESTS from time to time shall be applicable to the Guest Teachers. Remuneration, leave rules, and other service conditions shall be governed as per the guidelines of NESTS.
- In case of any dispute, the decision of the EMRS District Level Committee shall be final.
